The City Council met in the Council Room on October 9, 2017 with the following members present: Chuck Steffenson, Monica Olson, Mayor Terry Aasness, Darek Buse & Bobbie Batesole and the following absent: NONE

Others Present: Lyle Olson, Ardell Hendrickson, Colleen Shores, Dave Bedore, Richard Novotny, Jerry Buse and Diana Olson.

All present stood to say the pledge of allegiance.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Aasness.

A motion was made by Batesole, seconded by Olson and carried to approve the October 9th agenda with the addition of school lease under old/other business.

A motion was made by Steffenson, seconded by Buse and carried to approve the September 11, 2017 Council minutes.

The Legion is not interested in the Dental Clinic property. The City had indicated at a prior meeting that the City is interested in the property. The Council was wondering when the City would take over ownership. Diana will contact the clinic to gain access and find out when closing will happen.

Lyle Olson and Ben Hohman would still be interested in being back up snow plow drivers.

A motion was made by Batesole, seconded by Olson and carried to accept the resignation from Darek Buse on the employee committee and appoint Chuck Steffenson to the committee.

Diana presented two resolutions concerning tax forfeiture and local decision making but since they were not on the agenda the Council decided to wait till the November meeting at which time they would be on the agenda.

Brad Nelson will not sign the permanent easement for the Woodside Street drainage. Jerry will work on making it work without being on his property.

Jerry will be filing the water tower to over flow before it rotates.

The City received a letter from the City attorney about the clearing the air meeting and some information on meetings.

Terry presented a copy of the lease the School has with the City of Brandon. Bobbie and Monica are on the school committee and will arrange for a meeting with the School board to revisit the lease with the City of Evansville and the School.

The Council discussed some on the rental housing ordinances.
